9	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or
10	rejection a proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the State of
11	Oklahoma; changing the percentage of legal voters from statewide to every congressional district of the
12	state for certain petitions; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

15	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
16	2ND SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
17	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
18	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
19	the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article V of the
20	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
21	Section 2. The first power reserved by the people is the
22	initiative, and eight per centum <u>percent (8%)</u> of the legal voters <u>of</u>
23	every congressional district of this state shall have the right to
24	propose any legislative measure, and fifteen percentum percent

1 (15%) of the legal voters of every congressional district of this 2 state shall have the right to propose amendments to the Constitution 3 by petition, and every such petition shall include the full text of 4 the measure so proposed. The second power is the referendum, and it 5 may be ordered (except as to laws necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety), either by 6 7 petition signed by five per centum percent (5%) of the legal voters of every congressional district of this state or by the Legislature 8 9 as other bills are enacted. The ratio and per centum of legal 10 voters hereinbefore stated shall be based upon the total number of 11 votes cast at the last general election for the Office of Governor. 12 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional 13 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in 14 the following form: 15 BALLOT TITLE 16 Legislative Referendum No. ____ State Question No. ____ 17 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS: 18 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends a 19 section pertaining to initiative and referendum petitions. The 20 amendment changes the percentage of legal voters necessary to 21 propose certain petitions from statewide to every congressional 22 district of this state. 23 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED? 24 FOR THE PROPOSAL - YES
