

1 a parent within fourteen (14) days following the delivery of the
2 remains. The policy and the disposition shall comply with all
3 applicable provisions of state and federal law. Upon the delivery
4 of a child from a stillbirth or a fetal death event, the hospital
5 shall notify at least one (1) parent of the parents' right to direct
6 the disposition of the remains of the child and shall provide at
7 least (1) one parent with a copy of its policy with respect to
8 disposition.

9 B. Except as otherwise provided by law, nothing in this section
10 shall be interpreted to prohibit any hospital from providing
11 additional notification and assistance to the parent of a child
12 delivered as a stillbirth or a fetal death event at the hospital
13 relating to the disposition of the remains of the child.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
