11 An Act relating to memorial highway and bridge
12 designations; designating the Gold Star Families
13 Memorial Highway; designating the Randy Peterson
14 Memorial Highway; designating the Sgt. Michael A.
15 Crawford Memorial Highway; designating the Sgt. Jason
16 McCluskey Memorial Bridge; designating the Lt. Heath
17 Meyer #64 Memorial Highway; requiring certain
18 markers; providing for codification; and providing an
19 effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.287 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 The section of U.S. Highway 277 beginning on the west side of
the H.E. Bailey Turnpike and extending west to the intersection of
U.S. Highway 62 in Comanche County shall be designated as the "Gold

1 Star Families Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
2 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
3 placed on the highway.

4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.288 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The section of U.S. Highway 69B beginning at the intersection of
8 Foley Avenue and extending north to the intersection of Selmon Road
9 within the municipal limits of Eufaula shall be designated as the
10 "Randy Peterson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
11 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
12 placed on the highway.

13 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.289 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The section of U.S. Highway 266 beginning at the intersection
17 with U.S. Highway 75 and extending east to the eastern municipal
18 limit of Dewar within Okmulgee County shall be designated as the
19 "Sgt. Michael A. Crawford Memorial Highway". The Department of
20 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
21 name to be placed on the highway.

22 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.290 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge over U.S. Highway 69 on U.S. Highway 270 within the
2 municipal limits of McAlester shall be designated as the "Sgt. Jason
3 McCluskey Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
4 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
5 the highway.

6 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.291 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The portion of Interstate 35 in the area one (1) mile north and
10 one (1) mile south of North 27th Street within the municipal limits
11 of Moore shall be designated as the "Lt. Heath Meyer #64 Memorial
12 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
13 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

14 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
