

1 3. Conspire to make a false report or perpetrate a hoax
2 concerning an explosive or incendiary device.

3 B. Upon adjudication, the court having jurisdiction over an act
4 described in subsection A of this section shall refer the juvenile
5 to the Juvenile Bureau or the Office of Juvenile Affairs to
6 formulate a plan of rehabilitation. Such rehabilitation plan shall
7 be considered by the court at a dispositional hearing after notice
8 is given to all parties. The state and the juvenile shall have the
9 opportunity to be heard at the dispositional hearing. The court may
10 modify or adopt the plan after such notice and hearing.
11 Additionally, the court may impose restrictions upon or suspend the
12 juvenile's driving privileges.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
