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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 611 of Title 10, unless there is
16	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. There is hereby created until January 1, 2022, the Task
18	Force on Trauma-Informed Care.
19	B. The task force shall consist of twenty-six (26) members as
20	follows:
21	1. One member who is an employee of the State Department of
22	Health appointed by the Commissioner of Health;
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2. One member who is an employee of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services appointed by the Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services;

- 3. One member who is an employee of the Department of Human Services appointed by the Director of the Department of Human Services;
- 4. Two members who are employees of the State Department of Education, one of whom shall represent the Sooner Start Program, appointed by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction;
- 5. One member who is an employee of the Office of Juvenile
 Affairs appointed by the Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs;
- 6. One member who is an employee of the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training appointed by the Director of the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training;
- 7. One member who is an employee of the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth appointed by the Director of the Commission on Children and Youth;
- 8. One member who is an employee of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority appointed by the Chief Executive Officer of the Health Care Authority;
- 9. One member who is an employee of the Office of the Attorney General appointed by the Attorney General;
- 23 10. Six members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives as follows:

12. Four members shall be appointed by the Governor as follows:

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- a. one shall be an officer or director of an association located in a rural area that identifies and promotes the development of a qualified workforce to support the emotional development of infants, toddlers and families,
- b. one shall be a representative of a private foundation that provides funding for early childhood initiatives,
- c. one shall be a recently retired judge with juvenile docket experience, and
- d. one shall be an individual with a history of adverse childhood experiences who received trauma-informed services.
- C. 1. Members shall serve at the pleasure of their appointing authorities. A vacancy on the task force shall be filled by the original appointing authority.
- 2. Appointments to the task force shall be made by December 31, 2019, provided that members appointed to the task force pursuant to Section 1, Chapter 112, O.S.L. 2018, shall continue to serve.
- 3. Members of the task force shall annually select from its membership a chair and vice-chair.
- D. The task force may use the expertise and services of the staffs of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate. The task force may, as necessary, seek the advice and

- services of experts in the field of trauma-informed care but without
 any reimbursement by the State of Oklahoma for any costs associated
 with such services.
- E. The task force shall study and make recommendations on a statewide, coordinated approach to preventing trauma in children, particularly the adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) associated with negative health and well-being outcomes across the life span.

 The task force shall also identify appropriate interventions and supports for children, youth and their families who have experienced or are at risk of experiencing trauma.
- F. The task force shall publish its findings and recommendations by January 1, 2022, including recommendations for any resulting legislation.
 - G. Travel reimbursement for members of the task force who are legislators shall be made pursuant to Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and travel reimbursement for members of the task force who are state or university employees shall be reimbursed by the respective employing entity.
- 19 SECTION 2. REPEALER Section 1, Chapter 112, O.S.L. 2018, 20 is hereby repealed.
- 21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
