NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 896.17 of Title 82, unless there 14 15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The Grand River Dam Authority shall promulgate rules and 16 procedures to allow for the beneficial removal of gravel from the 17 Illinois River system and the Barren Fork River system in eastern 18 Oklahoma. These rules shall provide for the beneficial removal of 19 gravel in areas of the river systems where it has collected in 20 overabundance creating a shifting and less than ideal river channel. 21 The removal of gravel shall be subject to all applicable state and 22 federal permitting relating to such removal from navigable waters 23 and waters of the United States. State permits for the removal of 24
