COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

[Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act -
motor vehicle registration - inclusion of information
relating to hearing status in the vehicle
registration system - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1112, as
amended by Section 1, Chapter 208, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018,
Section 1112), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1112. A. Every owner of a vehicle possessing a
certificate of title shall, before using the same in this state,
make an application for the registration of such vehicle with a
motor license agent. The application shall contain such information
as shall be required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission. Every owner,

1 when making application for registration, shall furnish the
2 following information:

3 1. A full description of the vehicle including the make, model,
4 color, manufacturer's serial or other identification number, any
5 security interest upon the vehicle, an odometer reading of the
6 vehicle when applicable, and the insurance security verification to
7 the vehicle;

8 2. The correct name and address, the name of the city, county
9 and state in which the person in whose name the vehicle is to be
10 registered resides, the driver license number of the owner if the
11 owner has a driver license or the Federal Employers Identification
12 Number of the owner if such owner is not an individual, and such
13 other information as may be prescribed by the Commission; and

14 3. a. The name of the carrier of the owner's insurance
15 policy for such vehicle,

16 b. The policy number of the owner's policy for such
17 vehicle, if available, or the name of the agent or
18 office where the existence of security may be
19 verified, if other than the carrier,

20 c. The effective dates of the owner's policy for such
21 vehicle, and

22 d. A statement of the existence of a nonuse affidavit if
23 filed by the vehicle owner pursuant to the provisions
24 of Section 7-607 of this title.

1 B. Any owner or lessee of a noncommercial vehicle possessing a
2 certificate of title may, at the time of initial application for
3 registration or application for renewal, inform the Tax Commission
4 that the owner, lessee or someone who may be operating the vehicle
5 is deaf, hard-of-hearing, autistic or suffers from Apraxia or a
6 communication disorder. That information, if provided, shall be
7 available to law enforcement through the Tax Commission's vehicle
8 registration system to assist law enforcement in identifying the
9 operator of the vehicle as possibly being deaf, hard-of-hearing,
10 autistic or suffers from Apraxia or a communication disorder. As
11 used in this section, "communication disorder" is defined as
12 impairment in the ability to receive, send, process and comprehend
13 concepts or verbal, nonverbal and graphic symbol systems.

14 C. In every case where a vehicle has been registered upon an
15 application containing any false statement of a fact required in
16 this section to be shown in an application for the registration
17 thereof, the Commission shall give written notice of at least five
18 (5) days to the owner of the vehicle, and shall require the owner to
19 appear before it for the purpose of showing cause why the
20 registration should not be canceled. Unless satisfactory
21 explanation is given by the owner concerning such false statement,
22 the Commission shall cancel the registration. The owner of the
23 vehicle shall then be required to immediately reregister the vehicle
24 and pay the required fees. The owner shall not be entitled to

1 refund or credit for the fees paid for registration of the motor
2 vehicle made under the application which contained any false
3 statement of fact.

4 D. The Commission shall insert in the application forms
5 appropriate notice to the applicant that any false statement of a
6 fact required to be shown in such application for registration
7 subjects the applicant to prosecution.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
