16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.7 of Title 57, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 Effective July 1, 2019, all correctional officers of the
20 Department of Corrections who are assigned to the following

- 9 13. Kate Barnard Correctional Center;
- 10 14. Lawton Community Corrections Center;
- 11 15. Lexington Assessment and Reception Center;
- 12 16. Mabel Bassett Correctional Center;
- 13 17. Mack Alford Correctional Center;
- 14 18. North Fork Correctional Center;

21 and who were employed by the state on the last working day of June
22 2019 and previously graduated from the correctional officer training
23 program of the Department shall be awarded an increase of Two
24 Dollars (\$2.00) per hour over their current hourly wage.

1 ~~SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.~~

2 ~~SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation~~
3 ~~of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby~~
4 ~~declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and~~
