8 An Act relating to driver licenses; amending 47 O.S.
9 2011, Section 6-121, which relates to extension of
10 driver licenses; modifying qualifying persons for
11 extensions; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-121, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 6-121. A. Any person who is in the custody of the
16 Department of Corrections and incarcerated within a facility of the
17 Department and who holds a valid **Class D** driver license, issued by
18 the State of Oklahoma for the operation of motor vehicles upon the
19 highways of this state, upon entry into custody shall not be
20 considered to have an expired **Class D driver** license for the
21 duration of such incarceration, not to exceed three (3) years, and
22 for a period of sixty (60) days from and after the release of the
23 person from such period of incarceration. This law shall not be

1 construed to confer driving privileges in any other jurisdiction
2 other than Oklahoma.

3 B. Any person or the spouse or dependent of a person:

4 1. Who is on active duty with the Armed Forces of the United
5 States; or

6 2. Who is currently employed as a civilian contractor with the
7 Armed Forces of the United States, living outside of Oklahoma and
8 having a valid driver license issued by the State of Oklahoma for
9 the operation of motor vehicles upon the highways of this state

10 shall not be considered to have an expired driver license for
11 the duration of such service or employment and for a period of sixty
12 (60) days from and after the return of the person or the spouse or
13 dependent of the person to Oklahoma from such service or employment.
14 This law shall not be construed to confer driving privileges in any
15 jurisdiction other than Oklahoma.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
