9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 1501, is
11 amended to read as follows:

12 Section 1501. As used in Sections 1501 through 1512 of this
13 title:

14 1. "Person" means any individual, partnership, association,
15 limited liability company or corporation;

16 2. "Music device" means any and all mechanical devices which
17 render, cause to sound, or release music where the same may be heard
18 by one or more public patrons, and each separate loudspeaker,
19 phonograph, juke box, or outlet from which such music emits shall
20 each be construed to be a separate "music device" as herein defined;
21 except in the case where the music emits from more than one speaker
22 transmitting from the same music-producing mechanism, in which case
23 the several outlets or speakers in each place of business shall be
24 collectively considered one such music device;

1 3. "Coin-operated music device" means any such music device
2 which is operated, motivated, released, or played by or upon the
3 payment or insertion of a coin, token or similar object, whether
4 there is one or more boxes or devices in the premises for the
5 reception of such coin, tokens, or similar objects; coin-operated
6 radio or television receiving sets in hotels, motels, or tourist
7 cabins for the use and benefit of the guests and visitors of such
8 hotels, motels, or tourist rooms or cabins shall be included in such
9 definition;

10 4. "Coin-operated amusement device" means any and all
11 nongambling mechanical or electronic machines which, upon the
12 payment or insertion of a coin, token, or similar object, provide
13 music, amusement or entertainment, including, but not limited to,
14 such games as pool, phonographs, video television, shooting
15 galleries, pinball, foosball, bowling, shuffle board, or any other
16 amusement device with or without a replay feature which can be
17 legally shipped interstate according to federal law;

18 5. "Coin-operated vending device" means any and all machines or
19 devices which, upon the payment or insertion of a coin, token or
20 similar object, dispenses tangible personal property, including but
21 not limited to cigarettes, candies, gum, cold drinks, hot drinks,
22 sandwiches, or chips. It shall not mean vending machines or devices
23 used exclusively for the purpose of selling services, such as pay

1 telephone booths, parking meters, gas and electric meters or other
2 distribution of needful service;

3 6. "Coin-operated bulk vending device" means a machine or
4 device which, upon the payment or insertion of a coin, token or
5 similar object dispenses to the purchaser ballpoint pens, combs,
6 cigarette lighters, prophylactics, filled capsules, peanuts, gum
7 balls, mints, perfume or novelties; and

8 7. "Coin-operated devices" means coin-operated music devices,
9 coin-operated amusement devices, coin-operated vending devices and
10 coin-operated bulk vending devices. "Coin-operated devices" shall
11 not include any device dispensing tangible personal property or
12 providing amusement where payment is made solely through the use of
13 a credit or debit card or other electronic or digital payment
14 process.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
