8 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending  
9 Section 160, Chapter 366, O.S.L. 2016 (37A O.S. Supp.  
10 2018, Section 6-120), which relates to furnishing  
11 alcoholic beverage to persons under 21; requiring  
12 certain program participation for violation; and  
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 160, Chapter 366, O.S.L.  
16 2016 (37A O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 6-120), is amended to read as  
17 follows:

18 Section 6-120. A. Any person who shall sell, furnish or give  
19 alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age  
20 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor for a first violation, and upon  
21 conviction shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars  
22 (\$500.00), or imprisoned in the county jail for not more than one  
23 (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any person  
24 convicted of a second or subsequent violation shall be guilty of a  
felony, and shall be fined not less than Two Thousand Five Hundred

1 Dollars (\$2,500.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00),  
2 or imprisoned in the State Penitentiary for not more than five (5)  
3 years, or by both such fine and imprisonment. The ABLE Commission  
4 shall revoke the license of any person convicted of a violation of  
5 this section.

6 B. Any person convicted of a violation pursuant to subsection A  
7 of this section shall be required to attend a victim impact panel  
8 program, as defined in Section 991a of Title 22 of the Oklahoma  
9 Statutes.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
