18	subsection shall be deemed a misdemeanor.		
19	B. The removal of any permanent mark or brand, including metal		
20	ear tags official identification, from any animal with a reportable		
21	disease or those classified as diseased in a herd being depopulated,		
22	without prior authorization from the State Veterinarian, shall be		
23	deemed a felony.
