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10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 1-3, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 1-3. For the purposes of the Oklahoma Agricultural
14	Code, unless the context indicates otherwise:
15	1. "Authorized agent" means a person who has been authorized by
16	the State Board of Agriculture to act on behalf of the Board in
17	making investigations, inspections, performing other services, or
18	doing any particular act or acts which have been vested by the
19	Oklahoma Agricultural Code in the Board. A written or printed
20	commission signed by the President of the Board shall be proof that
21	the holder has lawful authority to act on behalf of the Board in
22	implementing the Oklahoma Agricultural Code;
23	2. "Board" means the State Board of Agriculture;
24	3. "Code" means the Oklahoma Agricultural Code;

- 1 4. "Department" means the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,
- 2 Food, and Forestry and its employees, officers, and divisions.
- 3 | Whenever the name "Department of Agriculture" appears in any law,
- 4 | contract or other document, it shall be deemed to refer to the
- 5 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry;
- 6 5. "Director" means the Director of a division established in
- 7 | the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry;
- 8 | 6. "License" means a written document issued by the Board
- 9 granting authority to a person to engage in a business, occupation,
- 10 or activity;
- 7. "Livestock" or "animals" means any cattle, bison, horses,
- 12 | sheep, goats, asses, mules, swine, domesticated rabbits, and
- 13 | chickens, turkeys, and other domesticated fowl, and any animal or
- 14 bird in captivity;
- 8. "Official identification" means any official method of
- 16 | identification approved by USDA, as described by 9 C.F.R. § 86.1, or
- 17 | the State Veterinarian. Official identification for specific
- 18 | species may be further defined within the applicable section of the
- 19 Oklahoma Administrative Code. Backtags shall not be considered
- 20 official identification unless the animal is shipped directly to
- 21 | slaughter. The term "official ear tag" is synonymous with "official
- 22 | identification";
- 23 9. "Permit" means a written document issued by the Board giving
- 24 | consent for a person to engage in an activity;

"Person" means the state, any municipality, political 1 subdivision, institution, individual, public or private corporation, 2 3 partnership, association, firm, company, public trust, joint-stock company, trust, estate, state or federal agency, other governmental 4 5 entity, or any other legal entity or an agent, employee, representative, assignee or successor thereof; 6 10. 11. "President" means the President of the State Board of 7 Agriculture. The President of the State Board of Agriculture shall 8 9 also be designated as the Commissioner of Agriculture; 11. 12. "Producer" means any person planting, raising, growing, 10 11 or harvesting agricultural products; 12 12. 13. "Quarantine" means a written document issued by the Board to restrict the movement of animals, birds, plants, or 13 agricultural commodities into or out of a specified area for the 14 15 control or prevention of diseases or pests; and 13. 14. "Stop sale order" or "stop use order" means a written 16 or printed order signed by the President or authorized agent of the 17 Board, prohibiting the sale, offering for sale, exposure for sale, 18 or use of any agricultural product, article, device, service, or 19 commodity covered by the Oklahoma Agricultural Code. 20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019. 21
