6 [ delinquent juvenile acts - rehabilitation plan -  
7 court to restrict or suspend certain driving  
8 privileges - codification - effective date ]

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-8-225 of Title 10A, unless  
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. It shall be a delinquent act for a juvenile to:

15 1. Make a false report concerning an explosive or incendiary  
16 device as defined in Section 1767.3 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma  
17 Statutes;

18 2. Perpetrate a hoax concerning an explosive or incendiary  
19 device; or

20 3. Conspire to make a false report or perpetrate a hoax  
21 concerning an explosive or incendiary device.

22 B. Upon adjudication, the court having jurisdiction over an act  
23 described in subsection A of this section shall refer the juvenile  
24 to the Juvenile Bureau or the Office of Juvenile Affairs to

1 formulate a plan of rehabilitation. Such rehabilitation plan shall  
2 be considered by the court at a dispositional hearing after notice  
3 is given to all parties. The state and the juvenile shall have the  
4 opportunity to be heard at the dispositional hearing. The court may  
5 modify or adopt the plan after such notice and hearing.  
6 Additionally, the court may impose restrictions upon or suspend the  
7 juvenile's driving privileges.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
