8 **[ Joint Resolution - Constitutional Convention -  
9 ballot title - filing ]**

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
12 2nd SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

13 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
14 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
15 the question, pursuant specifically to Section 2 of Article XXIV of  
16 the Oklahoma Constitution, of calling a Constitutional Convention  
17 which shall be authorized to propose alterations, revisions or  
18 amendments to the Oklahoma Constitution or to propose a new  
19 Constitution for the State of Oklahoma.

20 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
21 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
22 the following form:
