6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to commercial driver licenses;
8 amending Section 1, Chapter 123, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S.
9 Supp. 2019, Section 230.17), which relates to
10 hazardous materials endorsement exemptions;
11 clarifying certain license holder residence status;
12 providing an effective date; and declaring an
13 emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 123, O.S.L.
16 2019 (47 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 230.17), is amended to read as
17 follows:

18 Section 230.17. A. Any person driving under a commercial Class
19 A license shall not be required to obtain a hazardous materials
20 endorsement pursuant to 49 C.F.R. Section 383 if the person is:

21 1. Acting within the scope of the license holder's employment
22 as, and within the state of domicile or another state with a
23 hazardous materials endorsement exemption, as an employee of a
24 custom harvester operation, agrichemical business, farm retail
outlet and supplier or livestock feeder; and

1 2. Is operating a service vehicle that is:

2 a. transporting diesel in a quantity of three thousand
3 seven hundred eighty-five (3,785) liters or one
4 thousand (1,000) gallons or less~~+~~, and

5 ~~3. Is clearly~~

6 b. clearly marked with a "flammable" or "combustible"
7 placard as appropriate.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
