6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Center for the
8 Advancement of Science and Technology; amending 74
9 O.S. 2011, Section 5060.10, which relates to
10 commercial application as a condition of assistance;
11 updating statutory language; directing the Oklahoma
12 Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology
13 to require as a condition of assistance that
14 recipients complete certain survey; providing for
15 contents of survey; directing certain board of
16 directors to develop certain policies and procedures;
17 providing an effective date; and declaring an
18 emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5060.10, is
21 amended to read as follows:

22 Section 5060.10. A. The Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of
23 Science and Technology shall require as a condition to any form of
24 financial or other assistance authorized by ~~this act~~ the Oklahoma
Science and Technology Research and Development Act before such
assistance is provided to any person, firm, business enterprise or
corporation that any patent, license, copyright, goods, services,
proprietary processes or other results of research that result in a

1 commercial application shall be developed or produced by an
2 Oklahoma-based firm or that a legitimate effort shall be made to
3 apply the results of financial or other assistance in a manner that
4 has a reasonable potential to create or enhance employment or other
5 factors contributing to economic growth within Oklahoma. The board
6 of directors of the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science
7 and Technology shall prescribe policies and procedures in order to
8 implement the provisions of this ~~section~~ subsection.

9 B. The Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and
10 Technology shall require as a condition to any form of financial or
11 other assistance authorized by this act that any person, firm,
12 business enterprise or corporation that receives such assistance
13 complete an annual survey. The survey shall require submission of
14 data related to jobs created and payroll generated in this state.

15 The board of directors of the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of
16 Science and Technology shall prescribe policies and procedures to
17 implement the provisions of this subsection including but not
18 limited to deadlines for submission of survey data and the frequency
19 of surveys.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
