SENATE JOINT
RESOLUTION 13

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 3 of Article XI of the Oklahoma Constitution; requiring that a certain minimum percentage of all revenue as stated in certain report for certain year for the permanent school fund be placed in certain formula; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
1ST SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 3 of Article XI of the Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:

Section 3. ~~The~~ A minimum of seventy percent (70%) of all revenue, as stated in the comprehensive annual financial report for the corresponding year for the permanent school fund, regardless of source, shall be placed in the average daily attendance formula including but not limited to interest and income of the permanent school fund, the net income from the leasing of public lands which

1 have been or may be granted by the United States to the State for
2 the use and benefit of the common schools, together with any
3 revenues derived from taxes authorized to be levied for such
4 purposes, and any other sums which may be added thereto by law,
5 shall be used and applied each year for the benefit of the common
6 schools of the State, and shall be, for this purpose, apportioned
7 among and between all the several common school districts of the
8 State in proportion to the school population of the several
9 districts, and no part of the fund shall ever be diverted from this
10 purpose, or used for any other purpose than the support and
11 maintenance of common schools for the equal benefit of all the
12 people of the State.

13 SECTION 1. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
14 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
15 the following form:

18 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

19 This measure amends Section 3 of Article 11 of the Oklahoma
20 Constitution. It requires that a minimum of seventy percent
21 (70%) of all revenue as stated in certain financial report for
22 the permanent school fund be placed in the average daily
23 attendance formula for schools.
