16	Section 2-129), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 2-129. The inspector shall be paid Ninety-five Dollars
18	(\$95.00) One Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$175.00) for each
19	election and shall be allowed mileage reimbursement at the rate
20	provided by the State Travel Reimbursement Act for mileage incurred
21	to receive or return ballots and materials for the election.
22	Judges, and clerks and counters shall be paid Eighty-five Dollars
23	(\$85.00) One Hundred Forty Dollars (\$140.00) for each election.
24	Provided, if an inspector, judge or clerk does not perform his or

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    her duties for the entire day of the election, the payment amounts
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    set forth in this section, excluding mileage reimbursement, shall
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    not exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of the original amount.
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    Precinct officials assigned to work a polling place ten (10) miles
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    or more from their home, shall be allowed mileage reimbursement at
    the rate provided by the State Travel Reimbursement Act for mileage

    incurred from their home to and from their assigned polling place.
    An additional Two Dollars ($2.00) per election shall be paid to each
    inspector, judge, and clerk and counter of a precinct from the funds
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    of the county. Compensation provided herein shall be paid for any
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    state, county, municipal or school district election; provided,
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    however, that compensation for elections conducted concurrently
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    shall not exceed in total the amount herein prescribed. Said
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    compensation shall be paid by the State Election Board for all
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    regular Primary, Runoff Primary and General Elections, all statewide
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    special elections and all special elections for United States
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    Representatives or United States Senators and State Senators or
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    State Representatives. Provided, the county election board may
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    appoint volunteer inspectors, judges, and clerks and counters who
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    shall not receive the compensation provided herein.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
