HOUSE BILL 2094

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
21 O.S. 2011, Section 302, which relates to criminal
penalties for disturbing legislative proceedings;
specifying penalty for certain unlawful acts; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 302, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 302. Any person who alone or in concert with others
wilfully disturbs, disrupts or interferes with any session, meeting
or proceeding of either house of the State Legislature or any
committee of either house of the State Legislature, whether within
or outside the presence of either house of the State Legislature or
any committee, by:

1. Engaging in violent, tumultuous or threatening behavior;
2. Using abusive or obscene language or making an obscene
gesture;

1 3. Making unreasonable noise; or

2 4. Congregating with other persons and refusing to comply with
3 a lawful order of the police or security officer to disperse~~+~~,
4 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a
5 fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by
6 imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding six (6) months, or by
7 both such fine and imprisonment.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
