7	An Act relating to agriculture; requiring grocery stores to offer certain eggs for retail sale under
8	certain circumstances; construing provisions; authorizing promulgation of administrative rules;
9	authorizing promutgation of administrative rules, authorizing submission of certain federal waiver or exemption; requiring Oklahoma Department of
10	Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to submit certain report; defining terms; providing for codification;

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-85 of Title 2, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. A grocery store that is a vendor participating in a federal
19	food program and offering specialty eggs for retail sale shall
20	maintain an inventory of conventional eggs for retail sale
21	sufficient to meet federal and state requirements for participation
22	in the federal food program.
23	B. This section does not require a grocery store to do any of

the following:

1. Stock or sell specialty eggs;

- 2. Stock or sell eggs if the grocery store elects not to stock or sell conventional eggs for retail sale as part of its normal business; and
- 3. Comply with the provisions of this section if the grocery store's inventory of eggs for retail sale was limited to specialty eggs prior to January 1, 2018.
- C. A violation of subsection A of this section by a grocery store shall not be construed to disqualify a grocery store from participating in a federal food program unless otherwise authorized by the United States Department of Agriculture.
- D. The Oklahoma State Department of Health shall assist the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in promulgating administrative rules necessary to implement and administer this section.
- E. If necessary to implement, administer and enforce this section, the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, in cooperation with the Oklahoma State Department of Health, shall submit a request to the United States Department of Agriculture for a waiver or other exception from regulations. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall regularly report the status of such request to the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma Senate.

- F. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:
  - 1. "Conventional eggs" means eggs other than specialty eggs;
  - 2. "Eggs" means shell eggs that are graded as "AA", "A" or "B", pursuant to 7 C.F.R. pt. 56, subpt. A, and that are sold at retail in commercial markets;
  - 3. "Federal food program" means the Special Supplemental
    Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) as provided
    in 42 U.S.C. Section 1786, et seq.;
  - 4. "Grocery store" means a for-profit or not-for-profit selfservice retail establishment that primarily sells meat, seafood,
    fruits, vegetables, dairy products, dry groceries, household
    products and sundries to customers intended for use, preparation or
    consumption off premises; and
  - 5. "Specialty eggs" means eggs produced by domesticated chickens and sold at retail in commercial markets if the chickens producing such eggs are advertised as organic or both as organic and as being housed in any of the following environments:
    - a. cage-free,

- b. free-range, or
- c. enriched colony cage.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
