HOUSE BILL 2253

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-101, which relates to voter registration; clarifying conditions for voter eligibility; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-101, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4-101. Every person who is a qualified elector as defined by Section 1 of Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution shall be entitled to become a registered voter in the precinct of his or her residence, with the following ~~exceptions~~ conditions:

1. Persons convicted of a felony shall be ~~ineligible~~ eligible to register ~~for a period of time equal to the time prescribed in the judgment and sentence.~~ to vote when they have fully served their sentence of court-mandated calendar days, including any term of incarceration, parole or supervision, or completed a period of probation ordered by any court; and

1 2. Any person who has been adjudged to be an incapacitated
2 person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the
3 Oklahoma Statutes, shall be ineligible to register to vote. When
4 such incapacitated person has been adjudged to be no longer
5 incapacitated such person shall be eligible to become a registered
6 voter. The provisions of this paragraph shall not prohibit any
7 person adjudged to be a partially incapacitated person as such term
8 is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes
9 from being eligible to register to vote unless the order adjudging
10 the person to be partially incapacitated restricts such ~~persons~~
11 person from being eligible to register to vote.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
