15	Section 850. The judge after the hearing provided herein may
16	order any property of the judgment debtor, not exempt by law, in his
17	possession of the debtor or under his control of the debtor to be
18	applied toward the satisfaction of the judgment, and may enforce the
19	same by proceedings for contempt in case of refusal or disobedience.
20	The judge may further order the judgment debtor to pay to the
21	judgment creditor or apply on the judgment in installments $_{ au}$ such
22	portion of his nonexempt income of the debtor, however or wherever
23	earned or acquired, as the court may deem proper after due regard
24	for any payments required to be made by the judgment debtor by

virtue of law or prior order of a court or under wage assignments
outstanding. Where the judgment debtor claims or is proved to be
rendering services to or employed by a relative or other person or
by a corporation owned or controlled by a relative or other person,
without salary or compensation, or at a salary or compensation so
inadequate as to satisfy the court that such salary or compensation
is merely colorable and designed to defraud or impede the creditors
of such debtor, the court may direct such debtor to make payments on
account of the judgment, in installments, based upon a reasonable
value of the services rendered by such judgment debtor under his
said employment or upon said debtor's then earning ability. The
court may, from time to time, modify an order made under this
section upon application of either party upon notice to the other.
A failure or neglect to comply with an order of direction of the
court_{\tau} shall be punished as for contempt, but only by imposition of
a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars ($500.00) as provided in
Section 566 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
```

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
