6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 requiring employers to provide confirmation of hours
9 worked to apprentices; defining term; providing for
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4004 of Title 59, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Every employer that employs apprentices shall provide, at no
16 cost, written confirmation of hours worked by the apprentice
17 annually, or within ten (10) business days upon request by the
18 apprentice. For the purposes of this section, "employer" means
19 every individual, partnership, firm, association, corporation, the
20 legal representative of a deceased individual, or the receiver,
21 trustee or successor of an individual, firm, partnership,
22 association or corporation, employing any person in this state.
