16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

19	In an effort to provide employees of political subdivisions
20	within the state the opportunity to support and contribute to fully
21	accountable private nonprofit social, health and welfare
22	organizations and agencies, on a voluntary basis, there is hereby
23	created the "Public Employees Charitable Campaign Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6002 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Though the political subdivision employers of the employees are prohibited from making direct appropriations of public funds to such organizations and agencies, nothing shall preclude or prevent the voluntary commitment by the employee to perform duties, functions and activities in support of said organizations and agencies. Said commitment of support by the employee may occur, with permission of the political subdivision, during the employee's work hours and on public property.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6003 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The political subdivision where employees are voluntarily involved in the support of said organizations and agencies shall establish an Oversight Committee for Charitable Contributions to establish rules and regulations to manage and control the employees' involvement and support of the organizations and agencies when conducted during work hours and on public property.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6004 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
