6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public finance; amending Section
8 4, Chapter 451, O..L. 2019 (62 O.S. Supp. 2019,
9 Section 8014), which relates to the Legislative
10 Office of Fiscal Transparency; requiring state
11 governmental entities to transmit certain information
12 to the Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency;
13 providing for procedures to be established by the
14 Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency; providing
15 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 451, O.S.L.
18 2019 (62 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 8014), is amended to read as
19 follows:

20 Section 8014. A. Each agency or institution of the state
21 shall, upon request, furnish and make available to the Legislative
22 Office of Fiscal Transparency all records, documents, materials,
23 personnel, information or other resources as the Office deems
24 necessary to conduct performance evaluations as required by this
act. Any record, document, material or other information made

1 confidential by law shall be provided to the Office, which shall
2 also maintain such confidentiality. All records, documents,
3 materials or other information of the Office shall be deemed to be a
4 record of the Legislature.

5 B. Each state agency and other affected persons shall cooperate
6 with the oversight committee and the Office in the providing of any
7 information requested. The oversight committee shall have the power
8 to conduct hearings, administer oaths, issue subpoenas and compel
9 the attendance of witnesses and the production of information as
10 provided in Sections 773 and 775 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
11 Statutes.

12 C. For the purpose of creating a data clearinghouse to aid in
13 the work of the Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency, each
14 agency or institution of the state shall regularly transmit to the
15 Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency raw datasets as requested
16 by the Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency. The Legislative
17 Office of Fiscal Transparency shall adopt policies and procedures
18 pursuant to which a state agency shall be required to comply with
19 the provisions of this section, including the format in which the
20 data is transmitted, how the data is organized and such other
21 matters as the Office may prescribe.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

23 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
