14	WHEREAS, as many as 32 million Americans have food allergies;
15	nearly 6 million are children under the age of 18; and
16	WHEREAS, research shows that the prevalence of food allergy is
17	increasing among children and adults; and
18	WHEREAS, eight foods cause the majority of all food allergy
19	reactions in the United States: shellfish, fish, milk, eggs, tree
20	nuts, peanuts, soy, and wheat. Symptoms of food-allergic reaction
21	can range from mild to severe, such as anaphylaxis; and
22	WHEREAS, anaphylaxis is a serious allergic reaction that is
23	rapid in onset and may cause death; and

1 WHEREAS, food allergy results in more than 200,000 emergency 2 department visits each year. Reactions typically occur when an individual unknowingly eats a food containing an ingredient to which 3 4 they are allergic; and 5 WHEREAS, the number of food allergy reactions requiring 6 emergency treatment is up sharply over the decade, with a three-7 hundred seventy-seven percent (377%) rise in insurance claim lines 8 with diagnoses of anaphylactic food reactions between 2007 and 2016; 9 and 10 WHEREAS, Food Allergy Research & Education (FARE) is a national, 11 nonprofit organizations dedicated to improving the quality of life 12 and the health of individuals with food allergies, and to provide 13 them hope through the promise of new treatments. 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 15 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE 16 CONCURRING THEREIN: 17 THAT May 12 through May 18, 2019 is hereby declared as Food 18 Allergy Awareness Week. 19 20 57-1-8948 SH 05/15/19 2.1 22 23 24
