12 Investigations; providing legislative intent related
13 to certain construction; providing legislative intent
14 related to utilization of certain resources by the
Board of Medicolegal Investigations and the Oklahoma
State University Center for Health Sciences; and
providing for noncodification.

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
19 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

20 A. It is the intent of the Legislature for the Board of
21 Medicolegal Investigations to partner with the Oklahoma State
22 University Center for Health Sciences (OSU-CHS) for the purpose of
23 constructing a building that includes adequate space for the Tulsa
24 location for the Board of Medicolegal Investigations, as well as

1 space for OSU-CHS as agreed to between OSU-CHS and the Board of
2 Medicolegal Investigations.

3 B. It is the intent of the Legislature for:

4 1. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations to utilize Five
5 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,500,000.00) from the funds
6 appropriated to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations in Enrolled
7 House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma
8 Legislature, toward the furtherance of the provisions of subsection
9 A of this section;

10 2. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations to utilize Four
11 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,500,000.00) from existing
12 agency resources toward the furtherance of the provisions of
13 subsection A of this section; and

14 3. The Oklahoma State University Center for Health Sciences
15 (OSU-CHS) to utilize Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) from
16 the funds received by OSU-CHS pursuant to Dean's GME program
17 transition payments, toward the furtherance of the provisions of
18 subsection A of this section.
