12 An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;  
13 creating a revolving fund; providing that the fund  
14 shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations;  
15 describing sources of funding; directing the  
16 Director of the Department of Human Services to  
17 provide a monthly report to the Senate  
18 Appropriations Chair and the House Appropriations  
19 and Budget Chair; stating contents of the report;  
20 providing that all monies accruing to the credit of  
21 the fund are appropriated and may be budgeted and  
22 expended by the Department; stating allowable uses  
23 for the fund; requiring certain procedures for  
24 expenditures from the fund; providing for  
codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 229 of Title 56, unless there is  
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1        There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
2 for the Department of Human Services to be designated the "OK  
3 Benefits Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not  
4 subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies  
5 designated to the fund by law. The Director of the Department of  
6 Human Services shall, at the end of each month, provide a current  
7 balance and statement of encumbrances of the fund to the Chair of  
8 the Senate Appropriations Committee and the Chair of the House of  
9 Representatives Committee on Appropriations and Budget. All monies  
10 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may  
11 be budgeted and expended by the Department of Human Services for the  
12 sole purpose of the acquisition, operation, maintenance, repair and  
13 replacement of the OK Benefits system at the Department of Human  
14 Services. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants  
15 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
16 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
17 Services for approval and payment.

18        SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
