**Research Analysis**

HB 1002 removes the possibility of imprisonment for the unlawful carry of weapons. The measure modifies the punishment for allowing a minor to possess a weapon by increasing the penalties for second and subsequent offenses. A second or subsequent offense is punishable by a fine of not less than \$250 nor more than \$500, imprisonment in the county jail for not less than 30 days nor more than 90 days or both fine and imprisonment.
