Research Analysis

HB 1009 provides a one-time bonus, to be paid by January 31, 2020, for teachers who attained National Board certification after June 30, 2013 and received a yearly bonus of \$1,000. The measure directs that teachers who attained certification after June 30, 2013 but prior to June 30, 2019, will receive an annual bonus of \$5,000 for the remaining years of the ten-year period. Teachers who work in high-needs schools and achieve National Board certification after June 30, 2019, will be eligible to receive an annual high-needs bonus of \$2,500 for ten years. Finally, the bill increases the minimum salaries for National Board certified teachers.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure in its current form shall award teachers who attained their National Board Certification after June 30, 2013 and received the bonus of \$1,000, a one-time bonus that would equal the amount had it been \$5,000. It is unknown at this time what the resulting fiscal impact would be for the “high-needs” bonus of \$2,500/year as it is contingent upon how many teachers would pursue that option.
