Research Analysis

HB 1013 increases, from ten to 25, the number of ombudsman positions at DHS that are funded by revenue collected from the Nursing Facility Quality of Care Fee. The measure modifies and renames the Oklahoma Options Counseling for Long-term Care Program by making it person centered and requires that it provide long-term care consultation prior to a person's discharge from a hospital or rehab facility. Further, the costs incurred by DHS to maintain the program will also be funded by revenue collected from the quality of care fee.
