**Research Analysis**

HB 1014 requires DNA samples collected upon booking be collected by trained medical personnel, law enforcement, judicial personnel or employees or contractors. The measure provides that if the jail is using Rapid DNA technology, the sample is not to be retained, tested or stored after completion of the identification process. The measure adds a condition under which the DNA sample will not be destroyed to include when the DNA sample is provided as a condition of a plea agreement.
