Research Analysis

HB 1018 as introduced requires that each school district provide age-appropriate instruction of HIV, AIDS, and related issues by providing the instruction at least once during the grades 5-6, at least once during the grades 7-9, and at least once during the grades 10-12. The bill directs the State Department of Education to make available medically accurate curriculum, however, school districts possess the option to create their own curriculum provided the curriculum is approved for medical accuracy by the State Department of Health. This bill repeals outdated language mandating AIDS instruction in school.
