**Fiscal Analysis**

The introduced version of HB 1038 changes the statutory salary amount for court reporters into to a salary minimum in order to allow these individuals to receive their state employee pay raise passed in the 2018 session.

The agencies involved are: Workers' Compensation Court of Existing Claims (non-appropriated) which employs 3 court reporters, Corporation Commission which employs 7 court reporters, and the district courts which employs 75 court reporters.
