Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the State Election Board anticipate no negative fiscal impact as a result of the provisions of HB 1070 in its current form. The measure allows for certain elections to fill vacancies to occur concurrently with Primary, Runoff, and General Elections; which would allow the avoidance of Special Election costs related to the vacancy. The State Election Board estimates a savings between \$350,000 - 400,000 for each occurrence of avoided Special Election costs.
