Research Analysis

HB 1110 provides that a person who deliberately dumps or discards garbage, trash, rubbish, refuse, debris or other deleterious substance on his or her own property in violation of any county or state zoning or public health regulation is guilty of a misdemeanor. The minimum fine is increased from \$200 to \$500.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1110 establishes a misdemeanor and increases the minimum fine to \$500. The measure also increases the minimum fine for a specific traffic citation to no less than \$500 and up to \$5,000. Overall revenue impact to the state from these fines is contingent upon how many individuals are found guilty and the amount of the fine they are required to pay.
