Research Analysis

The FA1 to HB 1111 allows an any person to carry a concealed or unconcealed firearm into any restaurant or other establishment licensed to dispense beer or alcoholic beverages where the sale of beer or alcoholic beverages does not constitute the primary purpose of the business. The amendment provides that it is lawful for a person carrying a firearm to be in a designated bar area of the restaurant as long as the person carrying the firearm is not consuming beer or alcoholic beverages. The amendment provides that establishments that derive 51% or more of its annual income from alcohol sales consumed on the premises must post signage on the entry doors that reads “51%”. The amendment provides that any patron who carries into a “51%” establishment and refused to leave is guilty of a misdemeanor.
