**Research Analysis**

HB1113 requires the State Superintendent of Public Instruction to submit a five-year public education plan to the Governor and legislature, beginning January 2020, and every year thereafter. The measure requires the plan to address funding requirements, policy reforms, and to be updated annually to reflect the Department's proposals for meeting future public education needs.
