Research Analysis

HB1157, as introduced, requires that healthcare providers accept multiple methods of payment from an insurer or health maintenance organization, including payment by credit card, beginning with plans in 2020. HB1157 also directs that in the case of payment by electronic funds transfer, the insurer will notify the healthcare provider of any fees associated with the payment method and advise the healthcare provider of available payment methods. HB1157 does not allow a contract to waive the provisions of this act. HB1157 directs the Insurance Commissioner to enforce violations of this act.
