Research Analysis

HB 1175 establishes criteria for the correction of information in a death certificate by a funeral director and provides that the director will be responsible for fees associated with the change. Allows certified copies of the certificate issued prior to the correction of information to be exchanged for the corrected copy. The bill also modifies who can obtain a copy of a death certificate to include a lineal ancestor or descendant of the person named in the record.
