HB 1177, as introduced, clarifies that the State Fire Marshal or agents of a county fire department or fire protection district may, at a municipality's request, enter onto an abandoned property for the purpose of abatement.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1177 in its current form authorizes the State Fire Marshal to perform certain actions under certain conditions, but does not mandate such actions. Due to the permissive nature of the authorization, it is assumed the State Fire Marshal would not elect to perform such actions unless the Marshall had resources available to perform such actions. For this reason HB 1177 in its current form is not expected to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or revenues.
