Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB1198 requires each agency, board, commission, department or program in the executive branch of state government to report its fiscal year financial information to the State Auditor and Inspector within 60 days of the close of the fiscal year along with a signed attestation from the chief financial officer and chief executive officer of entity.

The measure also requires the chief executive officer of said entities to sign and attest to the accuracy of all financial statements. Failure to sign the required documents or making false claims for payment of public funds will be considered a felony crime punishable by a fine of up to \$10,000 or two years in person, or both fine and imprisonment.
