Research Analysis

HB 1216, as introduced, directs the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to pay all costs associated with signage related to naming of highways and bridges on the state highway system. The measure also removes qualifications for dedications of highways and bridges in honor of individuals.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1216 in its current form changes the law to provide that the Department of Transportation (ODOT) shall absorb costs associated with signage for all highway and bridge namings on the state highway system. Under current law the costs of certain namings are the responsibility of the groups requesting the namings. Officials for ODOT have analyzed the three most recent years of costs related to such namings, and anticipate a cost increase to ODOT of \$8,000 per year as a result of the provisions of HB 1216 in its current form.
