**Research Analysis**

HB 1223 removes references to recital of death and heirship. The measure provides that if a child is listed in an affidavit the affidavit must indicate if the child was born to the surviving spouse or adopted by the decedent. The affidavit must contain a description of the land which may be affected. The measure provides that if an heir sells his or her intestate interest pursuant to Section 8 of Title 84 of the Oklahoma Statutes, then the intestate share is to be deducted and no longer be subject to the affidavit. After the sale, the intestate heirs or successor are prevented from claiming any additional interest through the affidavit.
