HB 1232, as introduced, places the Construction Industries Board in charge of administration of the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission Act. The measure also clarifies the board's role in administering the Roofing Contractor Registration Act. The Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission would become an advisory board to the Construction Industries Board.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure, as written, is anticipated to remove some administrative costs with the agency in the elimination of some duplicative employee positions. After implementation, there is a possibility of an increase in permit fees paid by various government entities to increase the agency collected fee percentage paid to the state for the General Revenue Fund.
