HB 1279 expands the requirements for admission of a minor to a hospital or inpatient mental health or substance abuse treatment facility to include that the minor has a demonstrable mental illness, or is drug or alcohol dependent, of sufficient severity to cause significant impairment in at least two of the following areas of the minor's life:

- family relations,
- school performance,
- school interactions,
- personal hygiene, hydration and nutrition, or
- self-protection.
