The committee substitute to HB 1299 adds the crime of assault, battery, or assault and battery with a dangerous weapon to the list of crimes for which a person convicted of such crime is required to serve a minimum of 85% of the sentence imposed.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1299 adds an additional crime to the list of 85% crimes. This could increase the amount of individuals incarcerated in Department of Corrections (DOC) custody. This increase is most likely minimal for DOC.

The average daily cost for one inmate in DOC custody is \$60.11. The annual average cost is \$21,940.
