Research Analysis

The CS for HB 1328 directs that DHS may not prohibit a child placing agency from recruiting, certifying or providing services for kinship foster family homes, unless prohibited in the contract it has with the agency. In addition, a kinship foster family home that receives services from a child-placing agency, in compliance with the contract between DHS and the agency, is eligible to receive the same reimbursement rate as other foster family homes.
