## **Fiscal Analysis**

Adding marijuana and electronic cigarettes to the list of those things you cannot smoke in certain places, widens the scope for related fines. Violations of this section are punishable by an administrative penalty of \$50 for the first offense within a one-year period, \$100 for the second offense within a one-year period, and \$200 for a third or subsequent offense within a one-year period. This could increase state administrative penalty revenue, however, the overall impact is dependent upon how many individuals are subjected to the penalty.
